This course enables delegates to conduct an evaluation of parent-child interaction consisting out of a pre-assessment interview, interactional analysis, and post assessment interview. The purpose of this evaluation is to obtain information about the parent-child interaction, strengths, and weaknesses in the relationship and to evaluate attachment and parental skills.

Delegates will also receive an observational evaluation structure as well as an interview structure for the pre- and post-observational interviews.

Social workers across different social work domains, are being confronted with clients being exposed to different traumatic experiences. Often social workers are the first responders in so far that they are often the first professional that clients disclose their trauma to and or reach out to for assistance.

By equipping social workers with foundational knowledge in a trauma support model as opposed to once off trauma debriefing, they can help reduce the psychological distress that is found after traumatic incidents.



THERAPEUTIC LIFE STORY WORK

Through life-story work a child is helped to make sense of their past experiences and develop a new secure emotional base. During this training course delegates will be introduced to theory underlying the concept of life story work and different types of Life Story Work. The focus will however be on Therapeutic Life Story Work and valuable practical techniques that can be used both in the context of life story work and in other therapeutic settings.

Life story work is a valuable tool to use in:

- adoption
- foster care
- attachment therapy
- trauma work
- and is suitable for all ages.



THE ART OF EFFECTIVE REPORT WRITING

Effective report writing is a crucial skill when working in any psycho-legal context. Regardless of how good practitioners are in the assessment or therapy of children – the report they submit is often the only physical evidence of their work and thus the saying "You are only as good as your last report".

This course will enable practitioners with knowledge and skill to write effective, neutral, and objective reports in line with their given mandate. Training is presented over four sessions. Structure and content of different reports from therapeutic to psycho-legal reports will be discussed in depth.

FACT's Advanced Forensic Training is aimed at social workers and psychologist who have successfully completed the training in Forensic Investigations of Sexual Abuse. The training will however also be valuable to social workers at welfare organisation's dealing with sexual abuse on a regular basis.

This course aims to address complex issues in dealing with sexual abuse investigations such as:

- Ethical issues in Sexual Abuse Investigations
- Assessing the Very Young Child Developmentally Sensitive Assessments
- Fantastic and Bizarre Elements in Children's Disclosures of Sexual abuse

Therapeutic Reunification is a therapeutic program that can be used where contact between a child and an parent has not realized for a set period of time. Therapeutic Reunification can be used in cases where allegations of abuse have been made, but findings are inconclusive or abuse has not been confirmed. It is further a valuable process to follow in other cases where contact has been frustrated for various reasons.

This course offers the delegate with a sound theoretical basis to understand attachment and related issues with the adoptive child.



ASSESSMENT OF ATTACHMENT: A MULTI METHOD APPROACH

This is a child-friendly approach where age-appropriate aids are used to obtain the necessary information. This information enables the professional to make recommendations regarding the use of further investigations and/or the planning of relevant therapeutic processes.

Experience in socio-emotional assessment of children is a pre-requisite for attending this training.
